



Instructions for use: **Hercules 8,000kg Snatch Strap**

Please read these instructions before you use your Snatch Strap

General information:

Before using the Snatch Strap it is the operator's responsibility to ensure that the Snatch Strap is not damaged and is in usable condition. Inspect for stray strands or broken threads in the strap and in the loops at both ends. If there is any sign of damage discard the Snatch Strap as its integrity has been compromised and therefore weakened.

NEVER overload the strap past its rated load limit.

ALWAYS ensure all persons are a safe distance from the Snatch Strap and winch cable throughout the recovery process and do not allow anyone to place themselves in the path of the vehicle performing the recovery.

To properly maintain your Snatch Strap:

- Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight
- Gently hand wash in warm, soapy water (mild solution only) and allow to air dry after use
- Never pressure wash Snatch Strap
- Never allow your Snatch Strap to come into contact with sharp or hot surfaces

When using your Snatch Strap

- Only use the Snatch Strap for the purpose it was designed for
- Never lift or tow with the Snatch Strap, or use it as a substitute for rope
- Do not tie knots with the Snatch Strap
- Inspect regularly for signs of wear and cease using if any damage is visible
- Do not allow the Snatch Strap to come into contact with trees, rocks or other sharp/rough surfaces when under tension
- Familiarise yourself with safe operating procedures before attempting to use the Snatch Strap

- Persons intending to use the strap should consider completing a nationally recognised four-wheel drive training course, or contact a four-wheel drive club for comprehensive advice on the proper selection and use of the strap
- The strap must not be used for lifting or conventional towing
- Persons intending to use the strap must ensure that the strap is not damaged and is in a usable condition
- The strap's strength and stretch are reduced when the strap is saturated with water
- An object such as a recovery damper, heavy bag or blanket must be draped over the strap during use to reduce any unintentional rebound of the strap
- Before attempting the vehicle recovery, passengers of the vehicles involved must:
 - Exit the vehicles; and
 - Stand as far away from the vehicles as possible; and
 - Avoid standing in the path of the vehicle performing the recovery
- The minimum breaking strength of the strap should be between 2 and 3 times the gross vehicle mass (GVM) of any vehicle it is used with;
- The strap must be suited to the gross vehicle mass (GVM) of the lighter of the 2 vehicles used in the recovery process.



WARNING

INCORRECT USE MAY RESULT IN INJURY OR DEATH!



Vehicle **OCCUPANTS** and **BYSTANDERS** have been **KILLED** by flying projectiles (such as tow balls) when recovery straps have been attached incorrectly.

NEVER attach recovery straps to vehicle fittings such as tow balls, tow bars, tie-down points or tow hooks.

ONLY attach recovery straps to an **APPROVED** recovery point/device that is suitably rated for use with the strap.

BEFORE attempting a vehicle recovery all passengers must exit the vehicles and stand as far away as possible.

12 MONTH LIMITED WARRANTY

WARRANTY PERIOD:

Full 12 month warranty from date of purchase against all manufacturing defects.

WHAT DOES THE WARRANTY COVER?

Under normal usage conditions, this warranty covers:

- a. Any defect in design or manufacture which results in the product failing to perform substantially as described in authorised advertising or literature.
- b. We will either repair or replace the product at our discretion providing that the fault is found to have been caused by a design or manufacturing defect and not misuse or tampering.

Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and for compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure. The benefits provided to you as the consumer by this warranty are in addition to other rights and remedies available to you under the law.

THE WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER:

- a. Any damage resulting from improper use
 - b. Faulty installation or modification made during installation
 - c. The cost of removing and reinstalling the product
 - d. Travel and /or other expenses due to customer's remote location
 - e. Transport charges and damage in transit. It is your responsibility to deliver and pick up your product, including any costs associated with the postage of your repair or replacement product. If you do freight your product we recommend that you insure against loss or damage.
 - f. Any loss directly or indirectly associated with the product failing to operate.
 - g. Damage caused by mould, insects, animals, misuse, incorrect operation, adverse weather, accidents and fair wear and tear
